

Safety Program Consultants, Inc. EMT-P to Paramedic Transition



During the next four years everyone in EMS will be going through a “transition” from levels of certification designated in the 1990s to new titles with new interventions and responsibilities. These changes have been planned since 2000 and are being accomplished in conjunction with the EMS Education Agenda for the Future: A Systems Approach. Hundreds of national EMS leaders participated in discussions with states and stakeholders to help everyone arrive at this decision over the past 11 years.

This course is for those EMT-Paramedics (EMT-P's) that were Nationally Registered that will now become Nationally Certified Paramedics. This two day-16 hour class will fulfill the educational requirements to meet this goal.

All NREMT-Paramedics who have expiration dates of March 31, 2011 or March 31, 2012 have two registration cycles (four years) to complete a state approved Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic to Paramedic transition course in order to be eligible for National EMS Certification as a Paramedic (NRP).

Completion of a transition course that is state approved must be validated by attending and successfully completing a course that issues a certificate that has within its title:

- NREMT-Paramedic's name
- transition course completion date
- The certificate must contain the following statement: "has completed a state approved EMT-Paramedic to Paramedic transition course."
- name of the sponsoring agency
- signature of the individual responsible for the training
- In order to transition to the Paramedic level, the NREMT-Paramedic is not required to complete National EMS Certification Examinations.

NREMT-Paramedics who submit an acceptable recertification application but do not include successful completion of a state-approved transition course from EMT-Paramedics to Paramedic will be issued National EMS Certification as an Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (NRAEMT) upon reaching their expiration date of March 31, 2016 or 2017.
